

COMPETITION RULES

“Win a Year of Study at Kingsley School”

§1. Competition Organiser

- The organiser of the "Win a Year of Study at Kingsley School" competition ("Competition") is Renaissance sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Suchy Las ("Organiser").
- The Competition is conducted on the territory of the Republic of Poland.

§2. Purpose of the Competition

The purpose of the Competition is to promote creativity and student engagement, and to encourage reflection on modern education.

§3. Competition Participants

- The Competition is open to students in Year 8 of primary school who intend to apply for the first year of secondary school in the 2026/2027 academic year.
- A participant may take part in the Competition only with the consent of a parent or legal guardian.
- Children of the Organiser's employees or persons directly involved in running the Competition are not eligible to participate.

§4. Competition Task

- The participant's task is to prepare a response to the following question:
“What does your ideal secondary school look like?”
- The competition entry may be submitted in one of the following formats:
 - a) a written response of no more than 500 words,
 - b) a multimedia presentation of no more than 10 slides.
- The entry must be the participant's own original work and must not infringe the rights of third parties.
- Each participant may submit one entry.

§5. Competition Entry

- A competition entry must include:
 - a) an entry form,
 - b) the competition work,
 - c) consent of a parent or legal guardian for participation in the Competition.
- Entries must be submitted by 10 July 2026.
- Entries submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

§6. Evaluation of Entries

- Competition entries will be evaluated by a Competition Committee appointed by the Organiser.
- The Committee will assess the entries according to the following criteria:
 - a) creativity and originality – 40 points,
 - b) quality of argumentation and coherence – 40 points,
 - c) relevance to the Competition theme – 20 points.

- The maximum number of points is 100.
- The Committee's decision is final and is not subject to appeal.

§7. Prize

- The prize is an exemption from tuition fees for the first year of study at Kingsley School in the 2026/2027 academic year.
- The prize does not cover fees other than tuition, including in particular fees for meals, trips, external examinations, educational materials, uniforms, or other additional services.
- The prize may not be exchanged for a cash equivalent.
- The prize may only be used by the Competition winner.
- To claim the prize, the winner must meet the enrolment requirements in force at Kingsley School, i.e. completion of primary school, no contraindications to attending a mainstream school, and signing of a study agreement.

§8. Copyright

- The participant declares that they are the author of the submitted entry.
- Upon the announcement of results, the winner grants the Organiser a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to use the competition entry for promotional and informational purposes related to the school's activities.
- The Organiser may publish the winner's first name, class, and excerpts from the winning entry.

§9. Personal Data

- The controller of participants' personal data is the Organiser.
- Personal data will be processed solely for the purposes of conducting the Competition, selecting the winner, and awarding the prize.
- Detailed information on the processing of personal data is available in the Organiser's privacy policy.

§10. Final Provisions

- The Competition is not a lottery or promotional lottery within the meaning of applicable law.
- The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Rules for valid reasons, provided that such amendments do not infringe participants' acquired rights.
- The Organiser reserves the right not to award the prize if none of the entries reaches the substantive standard warranting its award.
